- 4 pairs of cotton socks
- 4 pairs of wool socks
- 2 pairs of old pants (combat or other ex :jogging)
- 1 pair of long underwear
- 3 shirts or light sweaters
- 2 Warm sweaters
- 3 pair of underwear
- 1 Raincoat
- 1 warm jacket
- 1 Tuque/ hat
- 1 work gloves

### **MANDATORY ACCESSORIES**

- 1 backback
- 1 water bottle
- Roll of string
- Tooth brush and tooth paste
- Towel, washcloth and soap
- Hair accessories to tie hair
- Sanitary pads if needed
- whistle (1)

### **OPTIONAL ACCESSORIES**

- Flashlight
- 1 pocket knife with locking system (blade of 4 inches max) Levels 3 and up only

### ITEM PROVIDED TO EACH CADET: Sleeping bag
